Foundational TEFL/TESOL Certificate: 40-hour Basic Certificate

Course Description – A 40-Hour, 6-module interactive online certificate program. The course covers the fundamentals of teaching English as a Foreign Language, including the following: lesson planning; teaching productive and receptive language skills and sub-skills; language awareness for the teacher; multimedia in the classroom; and Computer Aided Language Learning (CALL).

US Chinese Culture Center TEFL/TESOL Certificate: 80-Hour TEFL Internship

Internship Description – An 80-hour inperson teaching internship in China designed to give trainees hands-on classroom experience while working with local students in authentic ESL/EFL settings.

Internship Objectives – Throughout the internship, trainees will:

- Develop lesson plans tailored to students' age, proficiency, and learning needs.
- 2. Create engaging teaching activities, games, and materials.
- Strengthen cross-cultural communication skills and classroom adaptability.
- 4. Receive constructive feedback from mentor teachers and supervisors.

Teaching Responsibilities – Trainees will:

- Plan, prepare, and deliver English lessons to small and large groups.
- Incorporate interactive methods (songs, games, role plays, etc.) to encourage participation.
- Assess student progress and adapt lessons accordingly.
- Collaborate with local teachers and staff to ensure effective classroom management.
- Demonstrate professionalism and cultural sensitivity throughout the placement.

Prerequisites – Trainees should successfully complete the 40-Hour Bridge TEFL Certificate.

Grading Criteria: Trainees should complete the following to earn a passing grade:

- Submission of a reflective TEFL essay
- A positive Internship Performance Report from the host school.
